### ADVANTAGES OF THE SOFT RESTRAINT CUFF

#### Legal

When restraining people, staff should legally use the least intrusive option. The Safer Handling soft restraint cuff can be used to negate the need to hold someone in manual restraint.

#### Injury

Metal and plastic cuffs are not very flexible and have edges which frequently result in injury to the person they are applied to. The Safer Handling soft restraint cuff is soft and manufactured from a material with a small amount of 'give' to prevent over tightening.

#### Adaptable

The Safer Handling soft restraint cuff allows for wrists that do not fit into regular handcuffs to be restrained. Too big or too small the soft restraint cuff fits them all.

#### Ease of Carrying

They easily fit into your clothing pockets or vehicle.

#### Secure and Lock

The soft restraint cuff has a 'secure and lock' locking method for added security.
